GOVERNOR APPOINTS PHILIBERT TO TEXAS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES



Governor Rick Perry has appointed Bill Philibert of Deer Park to the Texas Municipal Retirement System Board of Trustees for a term ending February 1, 2019. The Texas Senate approved the appointment on March 27, 2013. The six-member Board of Trustees oversees the Texas Municipal Retirement System, which is responsible for providing retirement benefit plans for Texas cities.

Mr. Philibert is director of Human Resources and Risk Management for the City of Deer Park. He is a member of the International Public Management Association for Human Resources, the Texas Municipal Human Resources Association, the Bay Area Human Resources Association, and the Society of Human Resources Management. He is also president of the Vista Villas Homeowners Association and Bay Area A&M Club.

Mr. Philibert received his bachelor's degree from Texas A&M University and his MBA from the University of Houston. He has received the Senior Professional Human Resources (SPHR) and Global Professional Human Resources (GPHR) designations from the Society for Human Resource Management.

Mr. Philibert replaces Mr. Ben Gorzell of San Antonio. TMRS thanks outgoing Board Member Gorzell for his dedicated service on the Board from 2008 to 2013.

TMRS is a public retirement system with more than 147,000 employee members in 847 cities. The System pays benefits to over 40,000 retired Texans and their survivors and administers a \$20 billion trust fund.
