- 1947–2001 Gaynor Kendall and son, Terry Kendall, serve as outside general counsel
- 2001 David Gavia hired as 1st in-house General Counsel
- 2005 Tish Root becomes Legal Assistant
- 2007 Michelle Mellon-Werch hired as 2nd in-house counsel
- 2010 David Gavia appointed Executive Director;
 Christine Sweeney hired as General Counsel
- 2012 2015 3 additional in-house counsel hired

Investments
