GOVERNOR ABBOTT REAPPOINTS ANALI ALANIS TO TEXAS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Texas Governor Greg Abbott has reappointed Anali Alanis to the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) Board of Trustees for a term ending February 1, 2027.

Mrs. Alanis was first appointed to a partial term on the TMRS Board on February 4, 2020. Currently, she is Chair of the Board's Budget and Compensation Committee.

Mrs. Alanis is Assistant City Manager for the City of Pharr, where she manages eight city departments including Police, Fire, Innovation and Technology, and Human Resources. She is the immediate past chair of the Rio Grande Valley Human Resources Consortium and a member of the International City/County Management Association. She serves on the Quality Texas Foundation Board of Directors, a statewide organization that assists both private and public entities to improve their organizational performance and efficacy. Mrs. Alanis received an associate degree in Business Administration and a bachelor's degree in Applied Technology Management from South Texas College in McAllen and a master's degree in Public Affairs from the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley.
