GOVERNOR REAPPOINTS JIM PARRISH TO TEXAS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES



Texas Governor Greg Abbott has reappointed Jim Parrish of Plano, Texas, to the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) Board of Trustees for a term ending February 1, 2023. Mr. Parrish currently serves as the Board's Chair. The six-member Board of Trustees oversees TMRS, which is responsible for providing retirement benefit plans for Texas cities.

During his first term on the Board, Mr. Parrish represented TMRS at the Texas Legislature, championed the System's strategic plan initiative, and voted on several actuarial changes and investment diversification decisions.

Members of the TMRS Board of Trustees are volunteers who are also participating members of TMRS and employees of TMRS cities. Mr. Parrish is the Deputy City Manager for the City of Plano. He is the past president of the National Public Employers Labor Relations Association and the Texas Municipal Human Resources Association. In addition, he is a member of the Texas City Managers Association, Leadership Plano, and Leadership North Texas. Mr. Parrish's certifications include Society for Human Resource Management SHRM-SCP, Certified Public Manager CPM, Certified Labor Relations Professional CLRP and ICMA-CP. Parrish received a Bachelor's of Business Administration and a Master's of Business Administration from West Texas A&M University.

TMRS is a statewide multi-employer retirement plan with more than 168,500 employee accounts in 883 cities. The System pays benefits to over 56,500 retired Texans and their survivors and administers a \$28 billion trust fund.
