During 2023, TMRS celebrated its 75th year of administering retirement plans for Texas cities. Starting out with eight participating cities, today we serve 935 cities and their employees, retirees, and beneficiaries. For three-quarters of a century, TMRS has thrived.

One of the most important ways we celebrated our 75th anniversary was by doing what we've always done: keeping your financial security and retirement needs first and foremost in our minds.

For example, in 2023 my TMRS colleagues have:

- Answered more than 70,000 Member phone calls

Tax Exemption Expanded for Qualified Public Safety Employees

Starting in 2023, the IRS allows "Qualified Public Safety Employees" (QPSEs) that have 25 years of service at any age to be exempt from the 10% early distribution tax when receiving a refund or lump sum payment from TMRS. QPSEs that leave employment at age 50 or later are also still exempt from the 10% early distribution tax. Additional information on the definition of a QPSE and the different exemptions is provided on the TMRS Refund Application and the TMRS Retirement Application, both located at tmrs.com. **

Account Statements Going Green

Your 2023 Member Account Statement will be posted in MyTMRS in March 2024. Statements will only be sent electronically, unless you opt into receiving a paper statement. Make sure you know your MyTMRS username and password so you can login quickly and easily in March.

Legislature Provides Cities with a new Repeating COLA Option

In May, the Texas Legislature amended the TMRS Act to provide participating cities with another repeating COLA option. The new option allows cities to calculate a COLA by only going back to the change in the Consumer Price Index for one year rather than to the actual date of the employee's retirement.

You don't need to do anything. A city does not have to adopt the new repeating COLA option.

Cities have three years (2023-2025) during which to adopt the new option. So far, 16 cities have adopted the new COLA: Addison, Alvarado, Andrews, Azle, Brookshire, Bunker Hill Village, Childress, Corpus Christi, Del Rio, Eagle Pass, Fairview, Gonzales, Memorial Villages

Police Department, Oak Point, Pasadena, South Houston, West Columbia, and Willow Park.
