## Discussion Overview



- A law enacted in 2019 (SB 1337) now allows TMRS board meetings to be conducted by teleconference or video conference, if desired.
- At the July 2019 Board meeting, the Board requested to consider establishing a policy to address the new options.
- Considerations:
  - Current Boardroom is equipped to handle some, but not all options.
  - Law requires when using video conference to audio record the meeting and make it available to the public.
- Staff reached out to three other Texas statewide systems to understand their practices.
- If the Board is interested in developing a policy, staff and Mosaic have provided some general questions to discuss.



### What is the Consensus Preference of the Board?

- 1. Does the Board prefer that Trustees attend meetings in person, rather than remotely?
- 2. Would the Board want to specify that, if a Trustee does participate remotely, they are expected to participate with the same level of focus and professionalism that they do when they attend meetings in person?
- 3. Can the Board Chairman participate remotely? If so, should the meeting then be presided over by the Vice Chairman?
- 4. Should roll call votes on agenda items be required when any Board members are participating remotely?

# What is the Consensus Preference of the Board? (continued)



#### 5. Would the Board want to:

- a. Utilize such meetings for a variety of purposes or more as a "last resort" option? If as a "last resort", what does the Board mean by that?
- b. Limit the number of meetings per year that could be done by teleconference or video conference?
- c. Limit the number of Trustees that could participate remotely at each meeting?
- d. Limit the number of meetings per year that each Trustee could participate remotely?
- e. Require annual reporting, perhaps at the time of Board self-evaluations, of each Trustee's record of attending meetings in person or by teleconference or video conference?
