Why Ongoing Board Education?

Why Ongoing Board Education?

It fulfills a Trustee's fiduciary duty

- The "prudent person standard" applies to all TMRS Trustee decisions
- Texas Constitution, Art. 16, Sec. 67(a)(3); TMRS Act, Sec. 855.303
 "In making investments for the retirement system, the board of trustees shall exercise the judgment and care, under the circumstances, that persons of prudence, discretion, and intelligence exercise in the management of their own affairs, considering the probable income from the securities and probable safety of their capital."

It complies with Pension Review Board (PRB) Requirements

- 7 hours of Core education topics in first year as Trustee
- 4 hours of Core or Non-Core topics within each two-year period thereafter

Frequency: Options
