TMRS Makes Final HELPS Payments March 31

Beginning April 1, TMRS will no longer deduct health insurance premiums from eligible public safety retirees' benefit payments. TMRS has communicated multiple times with cities and all the affected retired public safety officers about this change.

Run a TMRS Beneficiary Designation Report

It is important that your employees designate a beneficiary(ies) for their TMRS benefits. Now, cities can run a report, "Members Without A Beneficiary," in the City Portal that identifies employees without a valid TMRS beneficiary designation on file.

Once an employee vests with TMRS, all prior beneficiary designations are no longer valid, and they must redesignate their beneficiary(ies).

Employees can designate beneficiaries online 24/7 using MyTMRS. If they don't have a MyTMRS account, they can create one at tmrs.com. Employees can also complete a TMRS Beneficiary Designation Before Retirement form, which the city can upload through the City Portal.
